

## **SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS POLICY**

By accessing "Aus Virtual Pilots Social Media Platforms" (Facebook Page, Facebook Group, Youtube and Instagram) (hereinafter "we", "us", "our", "Aus Virtual Pilots Management", "AVP"). You agree to be legally bound by the following terms. If you do not agree to be legally bound by all of the following terms then please do not access and/or use "Aus Virtual Pilots Social channels."

- 1.The login credentials for access to our social channels which are provided to you by the service provider, serve as being your individual membership access to the relevant Aus Virtual Pilots social media platforms.
- 2.Members are to at all times behave in a courteous and respectful manner when using any of the Aus Virtual Pilots social media platforms.
- 3.Members are prohibited from the usage of excessive CAPS to draw emphasis or attract attention whenever using any of the Aus Virtual Pilots social media platforms. It is considered to be shouting and rude, Aus Virtual Pilots Management instead reserves the right to use CAPS for the purpose of displaying important announcements.
- 4.Members allow Aus Virtual Pilots to use any screenshots submitted for use on the website, documents, social media platforms and promotional materials etcetera.
- 5.Multiple or repeated posting of threads, comments or information in order to increase your views is prohibited.
- 6.Advertising, spamming and trolling is not allowed. This includes exploiting any of the features made available on the Aus Virtual Pilots social media platforms to spam members.
- 7.Posts that are sexual, political, race-orientated and religious in nature or violate Aus Virtual Pilots standards are not allowed.
- 8.Discussion of illegal activities through the use of Aus Virtual Pilots social media platforms such as tips for software on terms of piracy and other intellectual property violations are not allowed under any circumstances.
- 9.Aus Virtual Pilots reserves the right to remove or moderate material on Aus Virtual Pilots social media platforms without prior notice.
10. Aus Virtual Pilots Management shall be the sole-regulatory authority in dictating what does and what does not violate community standards or other relevant policies.

## WEBSITE POLICY

By accessing "Aus Virtual Pilots website" (hereinafter "we", "us", "our", "Aus Virtual Pilots Management", "AVP"). You agree to be legally bound by the following terms. If you do not agree to be legally bound by all of the following terms then please do not access and/or use "Aus Virtual Pilots Social channels."

- 1.The login credentials, which are provided to you, serve as being your individual membership identification on the Aus Virtual Pilots Website. You may not under any circumstances provide, give or surrender permission or knowingly allow your username or password to be used by anyone else other than Aus Virtual Pilots management.
- 2.Members are to at all times behave in a courteous and respectful manner when using any of the provided features on the Aus Virtual Pilots Website.
- 3.Members allow Aus Virtual Pilots to use any screenshots submitted for use on the website, documents, promotional materials etcetera.
- 4.Multiple or repeated posting of threads, comments or information in order to increase your post count is not permitted.
- 5.Advertising, spamming and trolling is not allowed. This includes exploiting any of the features made available on the Aus Virtual Pilots website.
- 6.Posts that are sexual, political, race-orientated and religious in nature or violate Aus Virtual Pilots standards are not allowed.
- 7.Discussion of illegal activities through the use of Aus Virtual Pilots such as tips for software on terms of piracy and other intellectual property violations are not allowed under any circumstances.
8. Aus Virtual Pilots reserves the right to remove or moderate material on Aus Virtual Website without prior notice.
9. Aus Virtual Pilots Management shall be the sole-regulatory authority in dictating what does and what does not violate community standards or other relevant policies.
- 10.The relative policy of Aus Virtual Pilots acknowledges and promotes the expectations placed on members to behave both within and outside the organisation.

13. Aus Virtual Pilots Management reserves the right to update these terms without prior notification. Remaining updated relies solely on the member. Violations of the subject policy may result in probationary period, a temporary suspension, termination or other form of disciplinary procedure to the members account and involvement with Aus Virtual Pilots.

## **11) DISCORD POLICY**

By accessing "Aus Virtual Pilots Discord" (hereinafter "we", "us", "our", "Aus Virtual Pilots Management", "AVP"). You agree to be legally bound by the following terms. If you do not agree to be legally bound by all of the following terms then please do not access and/or use "Aus Virtual Pilots Social channels."

The following clauses apply to all forms of communication on Discord, including voice, public text and private text.

1. Aus Virtual Pilots members must not release this server information to anyone outside Aus Virtual Pilots.
2. Abusive, rude, impolite or any language that is deemed disrespectful will not be tolerated.
3. Discussion that is sexual, political, race-orientated and religious in nature or violates Discord standards is prohibited.
4. Aus Virtual Pilots members are prohibited from bullying, mocking or disrespecting their fellow members in any way at any time.
5. Aus Virtual Pilots members must respect the use of text channels as outlined in the pinned post.
6. Advertising of outside organisations is not permitted under any circumstances, with the exception of Aus Virtual Pilots partners.
7. Aus Virtual Pilots members must adhere to all staff directions while on the Discord Server.

8. Voice changing or altering software is prohibited from use at all times when connected to the server unless used by event staff.
9. Pilots must use their first name as their nickname in the Aus Virtual Pilots Discord as per the rules page whilst connected to this server.
10. Spam messaging text chats is prohibited.
11. Respect the Staff, they are here to help you!
12. Constant spam messaging to a direct staff and unnecessary tagging is an offence and may incur a warning, if not a ban.
13. Aus Virtual Pilots Management reserves the right to update these terms without prior notification. Remaining updated relies solely on the pilot
14. While using the screenshot channel pilots can post a maximum of 6 pictures per flight to avoid spamming the screenshot channel
15. Pilots may be sent sensitive information. Sharing sensitive or private and confidential information will lead to disciplinary action

Violations of this policy will result in severe consequences.

First offence: Discord warning.

Second offence: 24 hour suspension from the Discord server.

Third offence: Seven day suspension from the Discord server.

Fourth offence: Permanent suspension from the Discord server.

Note: Aus Virtual Pilots Staff can deviate from this procedure at any time at their own judgement.
